School Bus Safety

The MEEMIC Safety Seekers™ visit your students to help them “seek out” tips to ensure a safe trip to school on the school bus.

This interactive program has the students practicing standing in line, looking both ways before crossing the street, and other safety steps. An activity sheet is provided to the students at the end of the program that summarizes the presentation and allows them to share their learning with their parents.

Fire Safety Program

The students have fun engaging in this fast-paced interactive presentation with the MEEMIC Safety Seekers™. A “mystery” bag is brought into the classroom that contains various items associated with fire safety (a few odd items are “discovered” in the bag as well.) The students “aid” the presenter in identifying what the items are and how they are used in fire safety. Topics reviewed include smoke detectors, dangers of matches/lighters, crawling below smoke level to safety, identifying a family meeting place, calling for help from neighbor’s home, and “stop, drop, and roll”. An activity sheet is distributed at the end of the program for the students to share their learning with their family!

This program works well in the higher elementary grades as well as in Special Education classes. The safety tips are discussed as we play the game. The game is played until everyone gets BINGO. Prizes are awarded to all students at the end of the program.
